### **ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY**

The University of Science & Technology, Meghalaya (USTM) is the first State Private University on Science & Technology in the entire North East India, sponsored by ERD Foundation, Guwahati. The University has been established in a picturesque landscape surrounded by tranquilled greenery in Assam-Meghalaya at Baridua, 9th mile, opposite to CRPF Camp, Ri-Bhoi District of Meghalaya. It is about 85 kms from Shillong, the Capital of Meghalaya & 6 kms from Dispur, the Capital of Assam. The campus is well connected by Rail & Air which is only 15 kms from Guwahati Railway Station & 48 kms from Guwahati International Airport.

The University has been established under the provisions of the University of Science and Technology, Meghalaya Act (No.6 of 2008) enacted by Legislative Assembly of Meghalaya and notified vide Gazette Notification No LL(B)87/2008/21, dated 02.12.2008 of Government of Meghalaya. The University is empowered by the University Grants Commission, to award degrees as specified by the UGC under section 22 of the UGC Act, 1956. USTM has also received necessary approval from BCI, AICTE, New Delhi; NCTE, ERC, Bhubaneswar, Pharmacy Council of India to run B.A.LL.B.(H), LL.B.(H) MBA, B.Ed. & B. Pharm courses respectively.

- ▶ 3 year LL.B. (H): Completed Bachelor degree in any stream securing in the aggregate not less than 45% of the total marks for general candidates and not less than 40% of the total marks for SC/ST/OBC candidates.
- ▶ I year LL.M. (Master of Law): Graduate in Law with 50% marks for general and 45% for reserved category candidates.

Provided that the candidates appearing in final year examination in aforesaid Programmes may also apply but at the time of admission/final registration they must produce result of the aforesaid Programme.
